ICD-10-CM Considerations • Chapter 5: Mental and behavioral disorders • ICD-10-CM code range F01 -F99 • Many coding decisions are based on a provider’s judgement (e.g., “in remission”) and clinical documentation • Psychoactive substances • only code abuse where documented, otherwise report “use” or “dependence”

Depression Coding Tips and Billing Examples - Home State ...

Avoid broad terms and unspecified codes such as “Depression”, F32.9 (ICD 10 CM code) □ Be thorough in picking up the details in documentation □ This can lead to a better understanding of the depression and assist with accurate coding □ Remember to code out other mood affective disorders, such as, Manic (F30.-) and Bipolar (F31.-)
